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### **REGULATIONS REGARDING EXAMINATIONS**

1. No learner may miss an examination without a VALID reason. Learners must provide, to her TUTOR, a DOCTOR'S CERTIFICATE upon arrival back at school or else she will receive ZERO for the examination.
2. A learner, who has missed an examination BUT brought the necessary note, will be expected to write the examination. It is her responsibility to make arrangements with her SUBJECT TEACHER for a suitable date.
3. Absence on non-examination days must be excused by a parent or guardian note.
4. All learners are expected to be at school at the normal time of 7:40 until 13:00 and must report to their examination venues immediately and line up alphabetically.
5. Please note that some 2<sup>nd</sup> session exams may finish later than 13:00. Learners are to check the noticeboards regularly for ending times.
6. Learners may NOT leave the school grounds between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> sessions.
7. All Gr. 8-11 learners will receive 10 minutes' reading time before each examination.
8. LEARNERS ARE TO WEAR CORRECT, FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM FOR THE DURATION OF THE EXAMINATIONS: no make-up; no non-regulation jewellery; only school suitcases; no handbags, canvas bags or string tied bags etc. – these will be confiscated.

9. Stationery must be housed in transparent pencil cases **or** stationery may be taken out of other pencil cases and left loose on the desk.
10. No Tippex is allowed at all.
11. No eating or drinking will be allowed in the examination venue.
12. NO CELL PHONES or other electronic devices will be allowed in the examination venue. These will be collected upon entering the venue. Please ensure that cell phones/devices are OFF and placed in an envelope and clearly marked with your daughter's name and surname. It is advisable to encourage your daughters to leave their cell phones/devices at home during the examination period. Please note: The school does not take responsibility for any damage, loss or theft of any of these electronic devices.
13. Remember that this school has a ZERO TOLERANCE for learners who are caught cheating; are in possession of any paper, writing or other material that may provide an unfair advantage to the learner; or who are caught communicating in ANY way with another learner.
14. Parents or guardians are asked to make arrangements for learners to be fetched from school on time so that they may get home and be able to continue studying for these examinations. Please allow for  $\pm$  30 minutes after each examination for collecting papers, admin and other logistical processes.
15. By law, no unauthorised persons or parents are allowed in any of the exam venues, or else an irregularity will be declared and learners will not be resultd for that exam.
